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# Getting Started

## Get in

The teacher gets access to the system on a web browser by going to <http://presenter.ed2.mobi/>. The teacher then keys in the previously-acquired id and password to log into the system.





# Presentation Bank

Presenter lets users to run their pre-configured EDtool presentations in the classroom. Teachers import a powerpoint (ppt/pptx) or pdf by simply uploading the file to the system.

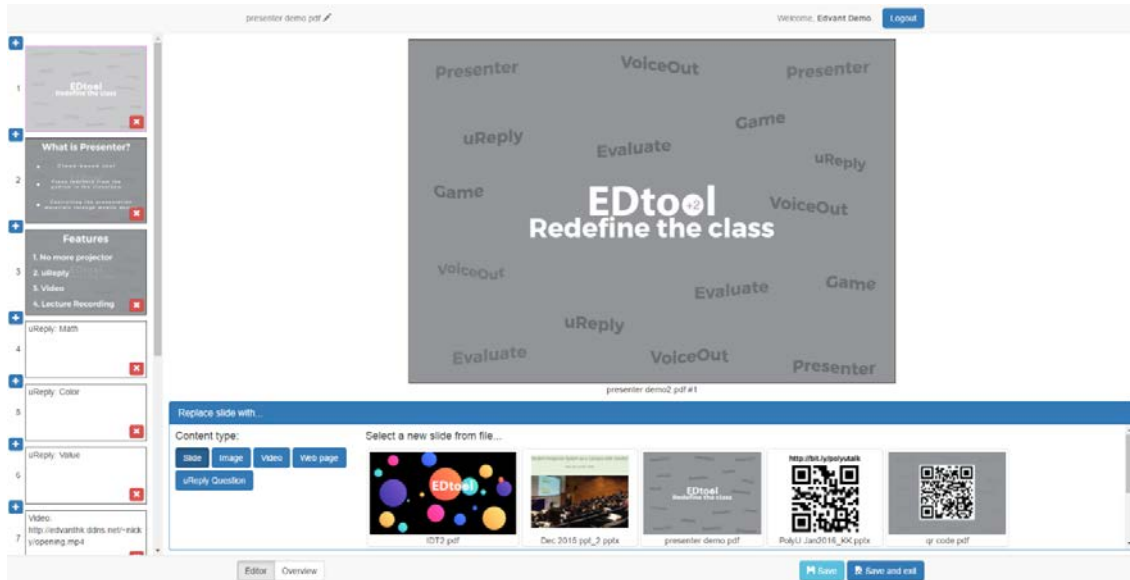

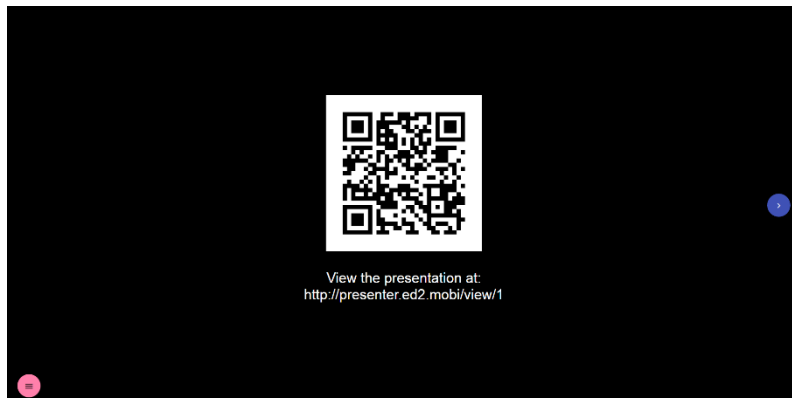
## Desktop control

A QR code will be shown. Students can scan the QR code or type the URL below the QR code to get to the presentation.

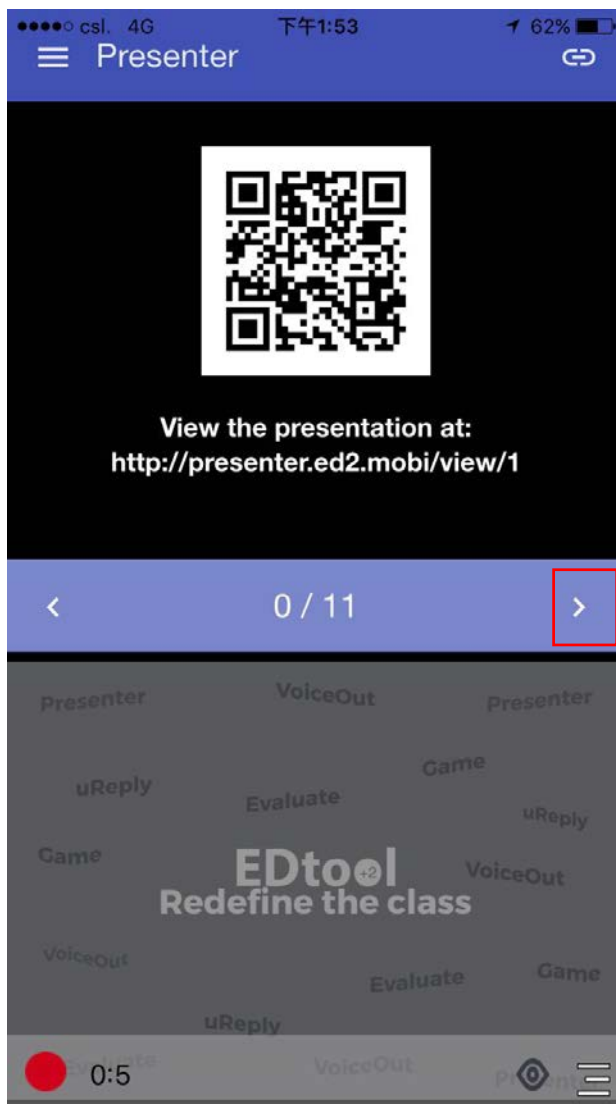


Teacher can to control the presentation on the computer or on his/her phone.

# Mobile control (IOS & Android)

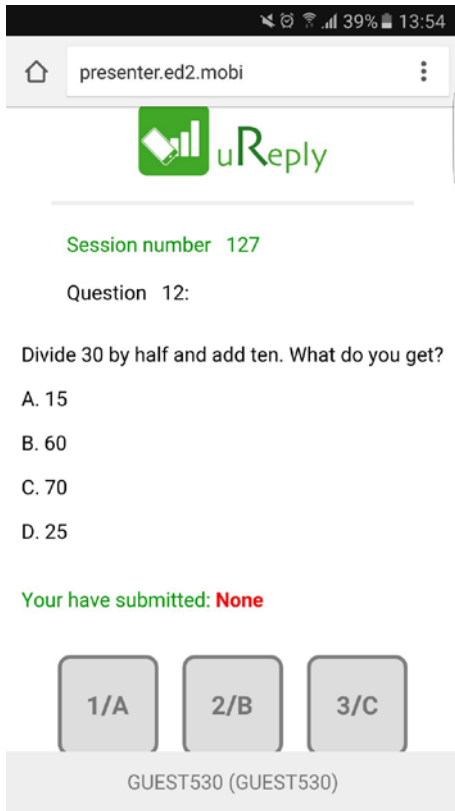
Teacher uses a web browser (<http://presenter.ed2.mobi/m>) or use the dedicated EDtool presenter app to control the presentations.

uReply questions can be controlled easily as well.

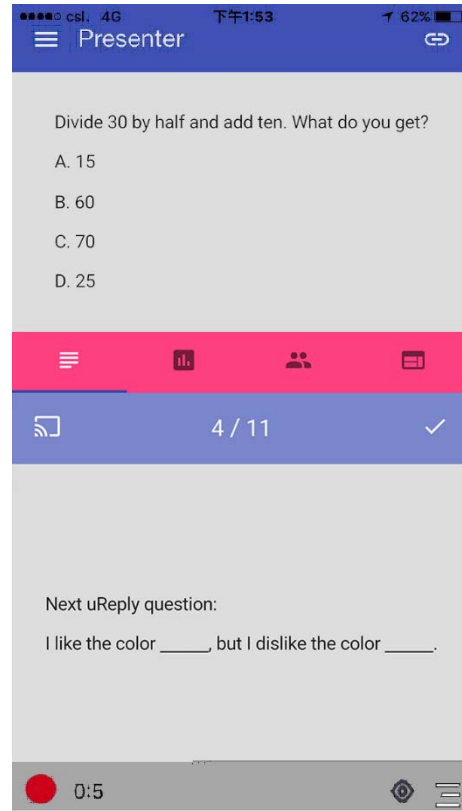


Next slide

Teacher side uReply

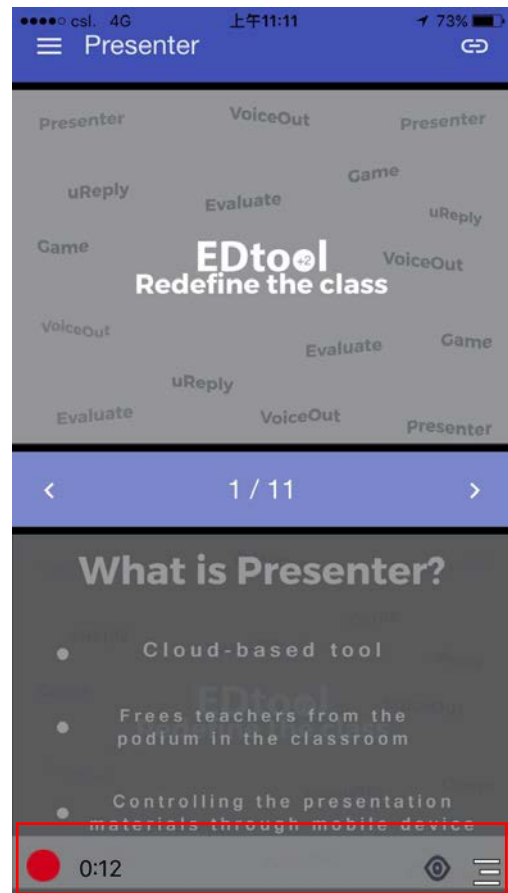


# Lecture recording

A special feature on the dedicated EDtool Presenter (IOS as well as Android) is the lecture-recording function.

The whole presentation including slides and the teacher voice will be recorded and saved on the mobile device.

Click the recording button on the app to start recording.



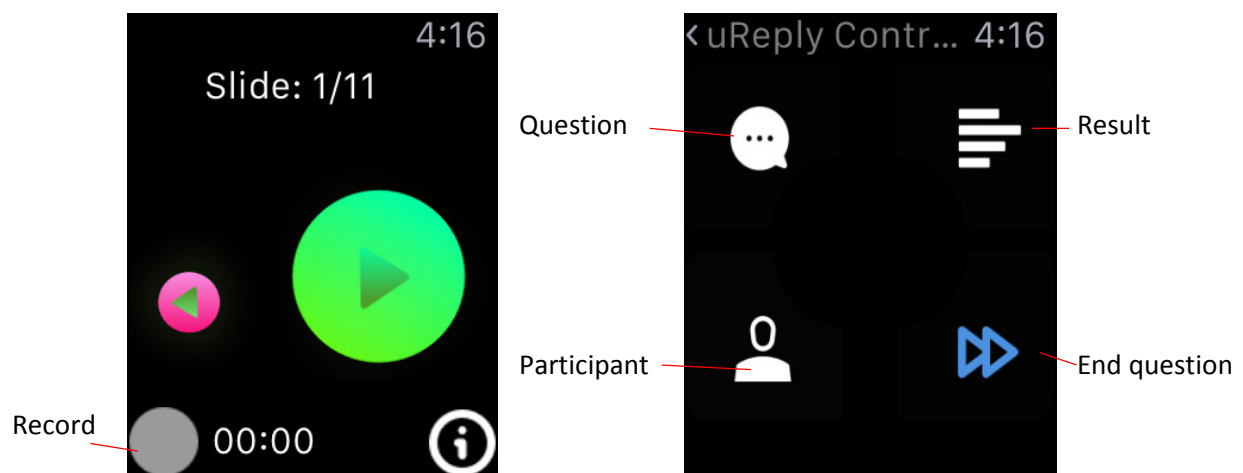

# Watch control (IOS only)

The presentation can be controlled on a Apple Watch as well.

Start the presentation on a classroom computer desktop as usual. Start the Presenter app on iphone as usual.

Then switch on the corresponding Apple Watch Presenter app on the watch to take over.
